ETHICAL CODE OF CONDUCT

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1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. This Code of Ethics defines a system of rules of behavior of students in the process of studying at the Kyrgyz State Medical Academy (KSMA).
2. The Code of Ethics is aimed at creating comfortable learning conditions, the most favorable psychological climate for students to communicate with each other, as well as with teachers and other employees of KSMA.
3. The Code of Ethics establishes mandatory rules of conduct for each student at the Kyrgyz State Medical Academy.
4. The administration of KSMA has the right to consider precedents of violations of the provisions of the Code of Ethics at meetings of the Student Board, departments, and the Educational work Sector and to make appropriate

conclusions, up to the announcement of a reprimand for violating this Code or taking other measures provided for by the Code.

5. Systematic non-compliance with the provisions of the Code of Ethics is the basis for the dean's office to initiate the procedure for reviewing the student's personal case with the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs.

6. Students can make suggestions to change the Code of Ethics.

7. The Code of Ethics is valid for an unlimited period of time.

2. TASKS OF KSMA STUDENTS

1. Active, purposeful, systematic mastering of the basics of professional knowledge and skills.

2. Timely and high-quality implementation of all types of educational activities provided for in the curricula.

3. Timely and high-quality passing of all types of certifications.

4. Study of specialized literature on the chosen profession, mastering the professional language.

5. Development of independence and originality of thinking.

6. Active participation in the scientific, educational and social activities of the KSMA.

7. Mastering the provisions of professional ethics.

3. PRINCIPLES OF EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITY

STUDENTS OF KSMA

1. Responsibility, activity, integrity, honesty, initiative, professionalism, decency, independence, collegiality and democracy.

4. STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Treat your studies responsibly, honestly, conscientiously, and strive to become well-educated specialists in your chosen professional field.

2. Students are responsible for the form and content of their course and thesis papers.

5. RULES OF CONDUCT IN THE CLASSROOM

1. The student should be actively involved in the learning process, remembering that both sides are active in learning – the student and the teacher.
2. Before the start of classes, students turn off their mobile phones or switch them to silent mode.
3. During classes (lectures or practical classes), students do not interfere with its conduct with conversations, movements and other actions, unless otherwise provided by the specifics of the class.
4. Students are recommended to come to class neatly dressed and combed, business style clothing is preferred. It is forbidden to come to the academy in shorts or sportswear. In the classroom, students are required to sit in white coats.
5. Students must stay in the classroom until the teacher arrives. If you are still late, you should knock, carefully open the door, say hello, apologize and ask for permission to enter. If permission is granted, you need to take the nearest available seat in the audience without attracting attention. The height of indecency in this situation is to greet anyone present personally, especially by the hand.
6. It is strictly forbidden to eat during the training sessions.

6. HEALTHY LIFESTYLE

1. The use or distribution of narcotic substances on the territory of the KSMA is strictly prohibited and entails immediate deduction.
2. Smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages, including beer, being under the influence of alcohol in the building of the KSMA is strictly prohibited and also entails a deduction.

7. FUNDAMENTALS OF ETHICAL RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN STUDENTS, TEACHERS AND ADMINISTRATION OF KSMA

1. Students, teachers and administration are like-minded people in solving the problem of higher professional education-the training of highly qualified specialists for the needs of the national economy. It is impossible to overestimate the importance of cooperation and mutual assistance as a condition for solving this task of the university.

2. Relations between teachers and students of KSMA are based on mutual respect, trust and collegiality.
3. Students observe subordination in their relations with the staff of KSMA.
4. A student of KSMA should be tactful, correct, polite, observe the fundamental rules of business communication, be responsible, honest, disciplined and obligatory in his relations with other students, with teachers and employees of KSMA.
5. The student should not allow actions and actions that humiliate the honor and dignity of another person, should be distinguished by benevolence and high culture, be positive when communicating with others.
6. A student of KSMA should show respect to the teachers and staff of KSMA and the university as a whole, be correct in their comments and assessments.
7. Students of KSMA are obliged to refrain from making critical remarks about teachers, officials, employees of KSMA and each other in the presence of other teachers, officials, employees and students.
8. If the student believes that the teacher or other official made a mistake, he should tactfully discuss this issue with him in private. If, as a result of the discussion, the parties do not come to a consensus, the student has the right to contact a higher supervisor to resolve the issue.
9. If one student believes that another student has made a mistake, he should tactfully discuss this issue with him in private. If, as a result of the discussion, the parties do not come to a consensus, the student has the right to discuss the situation with the adviser or a representative of his dean's office.

8. ETHICAL FOUNDATIONS OF THE STUDENT'S ATTITUDE TO KSMA

1. Students of KSMA are obliged to take care of the preservation and development of the traditions of KSMA, to provide all possible assistance and assistance in the education and training of junior students, to keep them from violations.
2. Junior students are required to pay due attention and respect to the advice of senior students.
3. Being in practice in state, commercial, public and other organizations, a student of KSMA should be aware that by his behavior he contributes to the

formation of the image and reputation of KSMA as a whole, and opinions about the quality of specialists trained in it.

4. The student must constantly maintain the prestige and authority of KSMA.

9.FINAL REGULATIONS

1 A student of KSMA should be aware that he is studying in a building of historical significance, and treat it with special care.

2 The provisions of this Code are mandatory for all students of KSMA
